



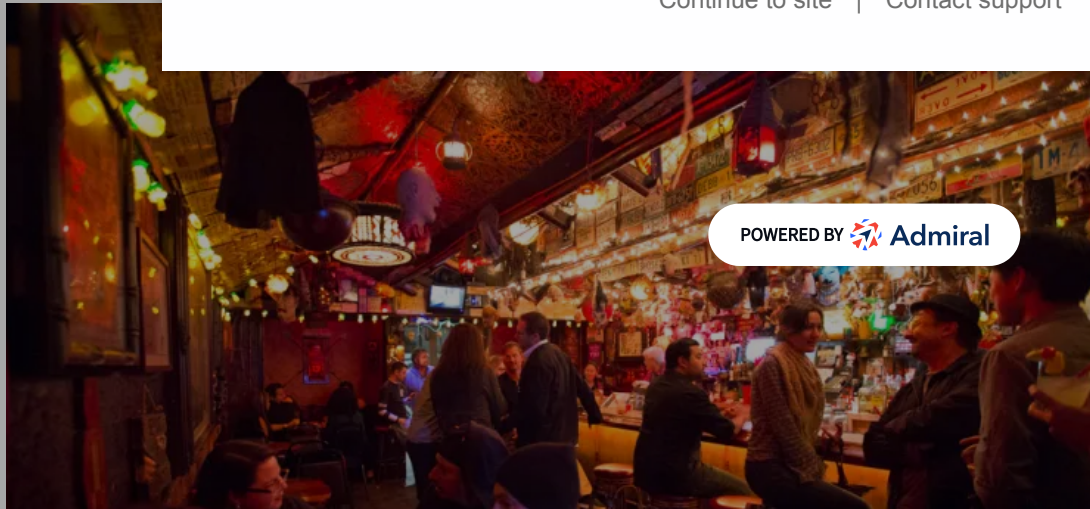

Tiki-Ti, Silver Lake’s nearly 63-year-old tropics-themed bar, will reopen after a temporary closure as co-owners Mike Buhen Sr. and Mike Buhen Jr. mourned the loss of Mark Buhen (Buhen Sr.’s son and Buhen Jr.’s younger brother), who was 40 years old at the time of his passing. Starting today, July 17, Tiki-Ti is open Wednesday through Saturday from 6 p.m. until midnight.

The family announced Mark Buhen’s death on June 25 via Instagram but offered no further information. In the statement, they requested privacy and said to check social media to confirm a reopening date. Throughout the years, the Buhens have closed the Tiki-Ti to take a vacation, for “restructuring,” and because bars were the **last to reopen** during the early days of the COVID-19 pandemic. The 12-seat bar had a five-hour wait when it resumed operations in 2021 as longtime fans queued for a Puka Punch, Zombie, or mai tai.

Great White in Brentwood

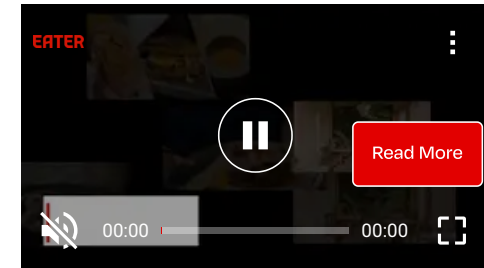
Toddrickallen spotted an Alcoholic Beverage Control license for **Great White’s** future location in Brentwood. The fourth Australian-style all-day

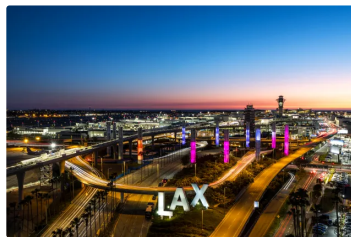
